3. ISAD(G) cataloguing guidelines

In reference to ISAD(G) elements:

1.3 Dates

Inferred dates are to be enclosed within square brackets []. A date span and broad date ranges can be abbreviated to 3 letters, e.g. 03-Apr-10, 03-Apr – Nov-10.

3.3 Accruals

This is only to be used if further accruals are expected.

2.1 Name of Creator

Follow the National Council on Archives (NCA) instructions for personal, corporate and place names. The NCA has a National Name Authority File:

Other authority files, from GLAM members, would be welcome as resources on the GLAM website and as models for future use.

4. MARC/ISAD(G) mapping

JG has mapped the 26 data elements of ISAD(G) against MARC and will produce a draft for consultation at the next working party meeting. It will also contain a mapping of Dublin Core elements alongside MARC and ISAD(G).
